How does it work?

Teams may employ one professional player. As a newcomer your level of training will determine the appropriate entry level for your team.

- 2 to 4: Maximum player handicap of 4
- 0 to 2: Maximum player handicap of 2
- 2 to 0: Maximum player handicap of 2
- 4 to -2: Maximum player handicap of 2
- 6 to -4: Maximum player handicap of 1
- 8 to -6: Entry level for a grass tournament with a maximum player handicap of 0
